It frankly took a lot for us to overlook the darkish colour and unabashed sediment of this wine, but all hesitation disappeared when the wine hit our palates. The flavours are clear as a bell, heightened by the delicate mousse. The wine is bone-dry but tender.

This ancient family firm has become a dependable source for some heart-warmingly traditional examples of Alsace wines. In recent years, they have systematically converted all their own holdings to certified organic viticulture, though they continue to buy a significant proportion of other grapes from long-term partners. The wines are full-flavored, varietally distinct and properly dry. They offer a price-quality ratio that is hard to beat. The 23 hectares of this estate are now fully organic.

Rather late in the day, both Vinous and The Wine Advocate have woken up to the quality of our producer, whose wines we have been importing since 1989. Welcome to the party!
